



## **Access Statement**

Le Cordon Bleu is committed to providing an excellent service to all of its users.

Access to Le Cordon Bleu, London is limited due to the number of stairs and constrictions within the building. To overcome these challenges, staff is happy to consult with the student on their specific requirements and incorporate them where reasonably practicable. Alternative venues are available.

Applicants are encouraged to disclose details of their disability on the application form. It should be noted that this information will remain confidential and not disclosed to any unauthorised person should the applicant so wish.

Applications can be made on line and supplied in large print if required both online and hard copy.

All supervisors and staff dealing with admissions have been supplied with a copy of best practice guidelines for ensuring the equality of disabled students in relation to admissions, enrolments and teaching practices

Applicants must note that teaching will take place at the school which has limited lift access to its 4 floors, There are currently no induction loops within the kitchens or demonstration rooms although there is some equipment available to help the visually impaired in the demonstration kitchens.

Applicants should note there is currently no suitable disabled toilet.

Le Cordon Bleu London cannot claim to be able to accommodate all students with difficulties but it will make all reasonable adjustments to do so.
